## Git With Other Default Branch

Sometimes the default branch name is not the name you want. However this branch name is hard-coded into <code>git</code>. One way to circumvent the usage of the hard-coded default branch, is to create a virtual new branch **before** the first commit.

When a new git repository is created the HEAD file is at that moment a pointer to the (virtual) default branch. One can easily find out with cat to what it points. The trick is to change the pointer for HEAD **before** the first commit and therefore before the default branch exists and making the new virtual first branch the default branch.

For all steps we assume a new repository was created similar to this approach.

```
cd /tmp

mkdir test

cd test

git init
```

( VS; PR ) Now the **very short** process to crate a git repository with a different default branch, without explanations, so **please read** it.

```
cd /tmp
mkdir test
```

```
cd test
git init
git checkout --orphan main
```

( ATL; DR ) The next example is basically (allmost) the same, but include some commands to prove it and explanations on what to expect.

( TL; DR) And finally the following session shows what happens, if there is a first commit to the repository, including the output of all commands.

cd /tmp

mkdir test

cd test

git init  # HEAD points to non existing ref:
    refs/heads/master
Initialized empty Git repository in /tmp/test/.git/
```
